Virtual PBX

- Least Cost Routing (LCR)
low-cost communication to GSM networks and from GSM networks to the fixed network
- Improving the availability of mobile employees
bundling of various numbers (e.g. reception, extension, mobile and fax) to one number
- More comfort for field agents
using features, which are usually not available on mobile telephones (call hold, call forward etc.)
- Optimize the infrastructure
replace DECT telephones with mobile phones

SMS Server

- Fast and comfortable interface between e-mail and SMS
- Sending SMS easily:
e-mails are written to the address of the coM.sat SMS Server
- Received SMS messages will be forwarded to the mailbox
- Legalize users by Black- und White-list
- Optimize costs:
routing of SMS messages to preferred GSM channels with a routing table

- Used with standard e-mail programmes (Outlook, Lotus, etc.) or a webmailer
- Standard POP3/SMTP mailbox
- Sending SMS messages to multiple recipients simultaneously with only one e-Mail
- Define groups of recipients
- Reply to a SMS is forwarded to the e-mail account of the sender
- Reports if SMS message was delivered successfully or failed
